

They meet fortnightly everyone where everyone provides an update on successes and issues coming from the local areas. In addition, the group then plan and act on key tasks, creating action plans and evaluating projects.


The Showcase event will take place on Tuesday 21st October, therefore all entries MUST be be submitted by 14th October
